Although Proposition A's paid sick leave requirement and the automatic minimum wage adjustments based on inflation, which were set to begin in 2027 were repealed by recent legislation, the minimum wage increases to \$13.75 per hour on January 1, 2025, and to \$15 per hour on January 1, 2026, are still in effect.

Preparing to attract more business for North Kansas City during 2026 FIFA World Cup

The North Kansas City Business Council is actively engaged with tourism-focused organizations in Clay and Platte Counties to be able to attract "more than our fair share" of customers from among the 650,000 expected visitors to the Kansas City area next June and July.

While many will be here for the six World Cup soccer matches at Arrowhead Stadium, all of those people and many others will have lots of idle time, looking for things to do, places to eat and places to hang out. Hotels as far away as 50-100 miles will be booked heavily during the 6-week period. North Kansas City can claim to have some of the best attractions for those staying in hotels in our area and to the north along the I-35 corridor, the Worlds of Fun area and along the I-29 corridor.

Resources from the Clay County and Platte County tourism departments are being deployed to create a new website and marketing promotion under the brand "GO North KC". Planning is also underway to host multiple watch parties in Northland communities. Here is a link to

MTS Contracting Recognized with Award



We are proud to receive the Adrian D. Anderson Award from the State Historical Society of Iowa Board of Trustees for our work on the William O. and Mattie M. Coffee House in Des Moines, IA (pictured below). This building is listed on the National Register of Historic Places and it was showcased as a model of purposeful restoration.

Our MTS crews in Ankeny, IA completed extensive work on this building. This included re-pointing the masonry, carefully removing and cleaning individual stones before re-laying them, and thoroughly cleaning and power washing the entire structure.
